Permission is granted providing the following provisions are met:

1. The initial burning may begin between 3 hours after sunrise and 3 hours before sunset. Additional fuel may not be added outside of these hours.
2. Prevailing winds **MUST** be away from any city or town.
3. **THE FORECASTED WIND SHALL NOT EXCEED 10 MPH.**
4. Care must be used to minimize the amount of dirt on the material being burned.
5. Oils, rubber, plastics, gasoline or similar materials which may produce unreasonable amounts of air contaminants may not be burned. Household trash cannot be burned and is prohibited.
6. The burning must be controlled so that a traffic hazard is not created as a result of the air contaminants being emitted.
7. The burning must be conducted on the property on which the waste is generated.
8. Permit holder shall be responsible for providing adequate safety precautions to control the open fire.
 - Burn piles shall be a minimum of 75ft from structures and high lines
 - The area around the pile shall be clear of excessive vegetation
 - Residential piles shall not exceed 10'X10' in area and shall not exceed 3' in height
9. Burning shall comply with Cashion City Ordinances and International Fire Codes.
10. **Cashion Fire Department shall be notified before burning and voicemail with name and callback number of Permit holder should be left at 405-433-2058**
11. **FIRE IS NOT TO BE LEFT UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME.**
12. Permit is to be on location at the time of burning.
13. Failure to strictly follow the permit guidelines shall cause the permit to be void and burning to stop
14. Immediately. Violation may cause this permit to be revoked and / or a citation issued.
15. At **Anytime** the fire is deemed to be unsafe by an Official Of **Cashion Fire Dept or Cashion PD**, the burning is to stop and be extinguished immediately by the permit holder or Fire Dept.
16. Permit shall only be eligible for 30 days after the permit is issued. Once the permit reaches a 30 day period a new permit will need to be obtained by the permit holder.
